The outreach family worker provides outreach family support with an early intervention and prevention focus to vulnerable families with children aged 0-8 or to parents in the antenatal period.

We develop appropriate activities and programs to enhance the skills and confidence of parents and aim to improve educational, social and health outcomes of the children that includes support, advice and referral for disadvantaged families, undertaking home visits where appropriate and establishing support networks for isolated parents.
